The Beet Retreat is a \*Vegan B&B and whilst everyone, Vegan or not, is warmly welcomed, I sincerely request that for the duration of your stay you honour that ethos and bring NO animal \*consumables of any kind onto the property. (See the last page if unsure what this means)

I also remind you that the main kitchen is NOT available for use aside from tea and coffee making facilities. Deliciously healthy meals are provided upon request and "The Treetops" room has a kitchenette for those who want to self-cater.

- Luxurious Pillow-top Queen Size Sleigh bed
- Spacious and luxurious bed-sitting room with couches
- Direct access to your own deck & from deck to garden
- Separate, private bathroom featuring large shower & bath
- Expansive north east facing valley views
- Reverse Cycle AC, TV/DVD, CD player, books etc
- Located at opposite end to the The Treetops Room.

#### **RATES:**

Holiday and Weekend: (Friday, Saturday) \$170\* per night.
Other Weekday: \$150\* per night.

Third person option possible **\$40** per night (see below re children) Companion animals are considered for this room.

With the option to be fully self catering with a beautiful kitchenette. The room is lockable from the rest of the house, allowing booking of this room in my absence. Vegan breakfast provisions are included in the room rate if I'm absent, but the usual in-house breakfast is served otherwise.

#### **RATES & PAYMENT DETAILS:**

- Your accommodation has been prepaid, with thanks.
- Meals, private cooking classes and hikes: Please enquire directly.
- **Gift Vouchers:** available to buy on our website and are valid for 12 months from the date of purchase.
- **REFUND POLICY:** FULL refund is available up to 14-days before your arrival. \$150 withheld if cancelled within 13 to 8-days of arrival. If you cancel within 7-days of checkin, no refund will be given.
- **RE-BOOKING POLICY:** You may re-book your dates, if this occurs within 7 to 14-days of arrival, a \$100 re-booking fee, will be applied.


#### **GENERAL DETAILS:**

# **MEALS:**

Big healthy breakfast is included in your room rate.

Dinner (including dessert) is \$35.00\*per person.

Focus is on healthy, mostly ORGANIC, whole-foods at The Beet Retreat.

Can cater for full WFPB, Raw, GF and most other allergens.

Please let us know at time of booking.

\*Dinners must be pre-paid.

Non-refundable if cancelled within 3-days of arrival



### **COOKING CLASS:**

- For 1-8 people and can be tailored to the individual or group needs.
- All are 3 hours hands-on PLUS 1 hour for the meal.
- Healthy, Whole Foods. Mostly organic ingredients.
- INCLUDES a sit-down main meal, including salad and dessert.
- INCLUDES Recipes, Ongoing Support and Advice.
- \$200 for a Private 3-hour Hands-On Class plus meal.
- \$140pp for 3-hour Hands-On Class of 2 participants plus meal.
- \$120pp for 3-hour Hands-On class of 3-4 participants plus meal.
- \$90pp for 3-hours Hands-On class of 5-8 participants plus meal.

"All classes must be paid for in advance via online booking and are non refundable if cancelled within 7 days of class"



### **BEET HIKES:**

- Hiking or Trail Running.
- HIKE and/or RUN: \$25 an hour.
- ADVENTURE BASED LIFE: Advice, support and training plans for those wishing to make hiking or trail running adventures in the outdoors a part of their life. Also ideal for those wishing to start multi-day hiking or adventure racing. Please contact me for more.



### **CHILDREN:**

- \*\*There is a third person option for the GARDEN ROOM upon application at \$40 per night.
- Children under 10 are NOT generally accommodated for safety reasons (high balconies, stairs).
- Also, a member of my fur family, Subi, is frightened and stressed by little ones.
- All animals here are rescues and their peace of mind is paramount.
- Children over 10 are welcome if BOTH guest rooms are occupied by the same party (so as not to disturb other guests) or sometimes during mid week when the likelihood of other guests is less.
- My apologies, but thank you for your understanding.



### **COMPANION ANIMALS:**

- Generally, The Beet Retreat is not suitable to bring your companion animals because my home is a safe haven for my two horses, cats, hens, sheep, my Kelpie Mac and numerous passing visitors (wildlife).
- All of the animals at The Beet Retreat have been rescued.
- If, however, you wish to contact me for special consideration to bring a companion animal, please consider the following criteria:
- Quiet, please! We enjoy a quiet life, so we request if your pooch is a barker... please reconsider.
- Because the resident cats are super friendly, it would be most important that visitors companion animals are comfortable around cats.
- All dogs MUST be kept under control at all times. On leash outside. No exceptions.
- No dogs on beds, please.
- The Garden room is the only room available for guests with companion animals as it has its own lockable decking which is lovely for a dog/s to go in and out of the room.


#### **THINGS TO DO**

Do nothing at all or have a big day out before returning home to a beautiful meal and a restful nights sleep.


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# **DIRECTIONS:**

### THE VEGAN THING

\*Vegan means that we do not eat or use animal products including meat, dairy, eggs and honey amongst other things...

I don't insist that this extends to guests garments or to their animal companions' food.

The resident cats here are not vegan, as it is my view that as cats are "Obligate Carnivores" it is unwise to tamper with their biology. Humans and dogs can both thrive as omnivores or herbivores.

Please note also that there are leather couches here that I purchased many, many years before I went vegan in 2012.

While I look forward to the day that I may be in a position to replace these with items that have NOT come from the animal agriculture industry, until said items become unserviceable, I, like many other vegans, will continue to use them.

It's a very different thing to knowingly support "animal exploitation" industries through the purchase of something new.
